

CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCRATCH MOTIF

1. Emboss **1008O Scratch Motif** once in copper and once in gold on white marl cardstock.
2. Colour the copper one as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut the entire piece out.
3. Colour the leaves and flower petals on the gold one as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut the leaves and each flower petal out separately.
4. On 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" sea mist cardstock stamp **992M A Faint Wind** randomly in gold, white and purple inks, each colour one over top of the other.
5. Mount the sea mist piece onto 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" white cardstock that has been edged with gold marker and then onto 4" x 4" white cardstock that has been edged with copper marker.
6. Cut beet cardstock to 11" x 5 1/2" and score it at 5 1/2" on the 11" side and fold.
7. Attach the mounted sea mist piece onto the front of the folded card using foam tape.
8. Attach the copper embossed Scratch Motif onto the mist piece using silicone glue.
9. Attach the gold embossed petals and leaves onto the copper Scratch Motif using silicone glue. Leave aside two flower petals.
10. Attach the two extra petals near the bottom of the front of the folded card with silicone glue to look as if they've fallen off of the flower.
