

## **CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR LADYBUG FRAME**

1. Emboss **1021T Ladybug Frame** four times on white marl cardstock using a black pigment pad and clear powder.
2. Colour one whole frame as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Add 02-Christmas red glitter to the centers of the swirls and cut the frame out (including the inside).
3. On the next one, only colour the leaves and ladybugs as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut them all out.
4. On the third, colour only the ladybugs and the big leaves they're sitting on as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Add 79-Black glitter to the spots on the ladybugs and cut them out.
5. On the fourth, colour only the ladybug on the right as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Add 79-Black glitter to the spots on the ladybug and cut it out.
6. Mount the frame onto 4" x 5 1/4" red linen cardstock that has been cut into a frame so that no red shows on the inside of the ladybug frame.
7. Attach clear acetate onto the back of the frame.
8. Attach foam core around the edges of the ladybug frame.
9. On 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" cream linen, emboss verse in black and rub shades of copper, bronze, black and brown cat's eye pigment pads around the edges of this piece.
10. Cut black linen cardstock to 10 1/2" x 6 3/8" and score it down the center of the long side and fold.
11. Attach 5" x 6 1/8" cream linen cardstock onto the front of the folded card.
12. Attach the verse into the center on the front of the folded card and attach the ladybug from the fourth piece in the top-right corner of the verse using silicone glue.
13. Attach the frame over the verse.
14. Using silicone glue, attach the leaves and ladybugs from the second piece.
15. Using silicone glue attach the ladybugs from the third piece.
