

CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR PANSY FENCE

1. Cut cream linen cardstock to 5 1/2" x 11" and score it down the center of the 11" side and fold.
2. Attach 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" yellow onto 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" burgundy linen and then onto the front of the folded card.
3. Attach 3" x 3" cream linen 3/4" down on 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" burgundy linen that has been edged with a gold ink pad. Attach this onto 4 5/8" x 4 5/8" cream linen and then onto the front of the folded card using foam tape.
4. Emboss **673S Classical Window** in gold on white marl and colour it as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut the window out, cutting off the top half-circle and cut the panes out. Attach acetate onto the back of the window and then attach the whole piece over the 3" x 3" cream linen piece using a double layer of foam tape.
5. Stamp **1037R Pansy Fence** in black on acetate and colour in the decorations on the fence with a gold pen and then trim around the outside of the fence. Attach this over the window using foam tape at the bottom edge.
6. Emboss the pansy fence in gold on white marl and colour it as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut out the pansies and attach them onto the acetate fence using silicone glue.
