

## CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR STAINED GLASS BUTTERFLY

1. Emboss **1059Q Stained Glass Butterfly** in verdigris on iridescent vellum, in Egyptian gold on 29 lb. vellum and in Chinese red on green confetti and on 4 1/4" x 3 1/2" gold leaf.
2. Colour only the outer edge of the wings and the body on green confetti as shown and blend with a paintbrush and water.
3. Add gold Liquid Pearls to the dots on the body and outer wings.
4. Cut this out and attach it over the butterfly on gold leaf by gluing the body and using silicone glue under the wings.
5. Colour only the center part of the wings as shown on the iridescent vellum and add gold Liquid Pearls to the dots.
6. Cut these sections out and attach them onto the green confetti wings using silicone glue.
7. Colour only the inside section of the top wings on 29 lb. vellum as shown and add gold Liquid Pearls to the dots.
8. Cut these sections out and attach them onto the iridescent vellum wings using silicone glue.
9. Mount the gold leaf piece onto 4 3/8" x 3 5/8" seamist, then onto 4 1/2" x 3 3/4" burgundy linen.
10. Cut beet cardstock to 11" x 4 3/4" and score it down the center of the long side and fold.
11. Stamp the front of the card randomly with the butterfly in Versamark ink.
12. Attach the mounted butterfly onto the front of the folded card using foam tape.
