

CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR SHELLS

1. Emboss **1074S Shells** in copper once on peach, once on ivory linen and once on jute.
2. Cut copper metallic cardstock to 5" x 10" and score it down the center of the long side and fold.
3. Paint some shading on the seashells on peach with a mixture of one part water and one part bleach. Add 977-saddle brown to the darker areas and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut the seashells out.
4. Cut out the each inner square on the ivory linen piece. Mount the seashells onto these with foam tape.
5. Paint some shading on the outer frames on the jute piece with the bleach mixture and add 977-saddle brown to the darker areas and blend with a paintbrush and water. Cut each piece out and attach the ivory linen/peach pieces onto the jute pieces with foam tape.
6. Glue these pieces onto 4" x 4" copper metallic cardstock, except use foam tape on the center piece.
7. Mount this onto 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" ivory linen and then onto the front of the folded card using foam tape.
