

CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR BEE LINE

1. Cut red linen cardstock to 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and score it at 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and another 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " along the 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " side. Fold this so there's a flap over the right side of the card.
2. Stamp **1251 Bee Line** in black repeatedly on 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " white linen. Shade the bugs in 856-chinese red and 990-light sand.
3. Attach this onto the 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " panel on the folded red card so half of it is visible on the front of the folded card when it's closed.
4. Attach 2 1/8" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " black onto the backside of the front flap.
5. Stamp **1250 Beetle Dots** four times in black on white linen.
6. Trim two bugs around the edges of square and colour fully as shown and blend with a blender pen.
7. Mount these onto 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " black.
8. Colour only the wings on the second two pieces as shown and blend with a blender. Cut these out and attach them onto the trimmed pieces using foam tape.
9. Corrugate anodized cardstock and cut two 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces. Attach these onto front flap so they are centered on the front of the card when it's closed.
10. Attach the ladybugs onto the corrugated pieces with foam tape.
11. Add Black Stickles to the dots on the ladybugs. Add Red Stickles to the dots in the background and for the accent on the Bee Line.
