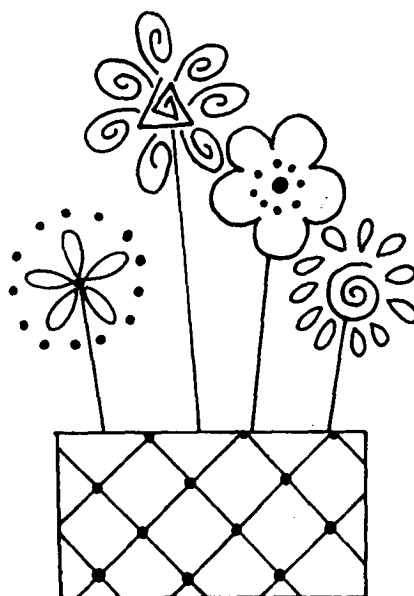


CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR STITCH FLOWER

Stamps	Cardstock
1325 - Stitch Flower	5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - Oasis
Markers	3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - Magenta
815 - Cherry	4" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - Oasis
	2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " - Magenta
	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ " - White Linen



Instructions

1. Stamp **1325 - Stitch Flower** in blazing red Stazon twice on white linen, trim one to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ " and using a cloth, tap into the stamp pad and then wipe along the edges.
2. Cut Oasis to 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " score and fold down the long side.
3. Layer the trimmed white linen piece onto the 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " magenta, then rip the 4" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " oasis to approx. 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{8}$ " placing the smaller magenta piece on top of the ripped oasis with a layer of foam tape and then onto 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " magenta. Layer these pieces flat onto the front of the folded oasis.
4. Using 815 - Cherry, apply to your plastic palette and pick the colour up from there using a small amount of water and a paint brush. Colour the base in completely and outline the flowers on the mounted piece. Do the same on the second piece stamped piece.
5. Cut out the base and layer it in place on the front of the card using foam tape. Do the same for the small and large daisy flowers applying silicone glue.
6. Add magenta stickles to the flowers and base.
