

# CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR CATTAILS WITH FLOWER

1. On 2 1/2 x 4 3/8 - Acetate, stamp **1430 - Cattails with flower** once in black permanent ink. When dry, edge with a gold krylon marker.
2. On a 3 x 4 7/8 - Red Linen piece, apply black, copper, and Chinese red embossing powders in blotches making sure not to get any outside the area covered by the acetate. Heat the red linen piece from the bottom so the powder doesn't blow away.
3. Using spray adhesive, attach the acetate to the red cardstock and then to 3 1/2 x 5 3/8 - Black.
4. Punch a 3/4" small circle out of cardstock. Place two 1/8 holes centered to create what looks like a button. Emboss this whole piece using gold embossing powder. String through a piece of black ribbon and secure this across the mounted pieces near the bottom of the image.
5. Layer this onto a 3 5/8 x 5 1/2 piece of white that has been edged in gold krylon marker.
6. Cut a piece of 6 x 8 1/4 - Poppy Red score and fold down the long side and attach all piece to the front of the folded card.
