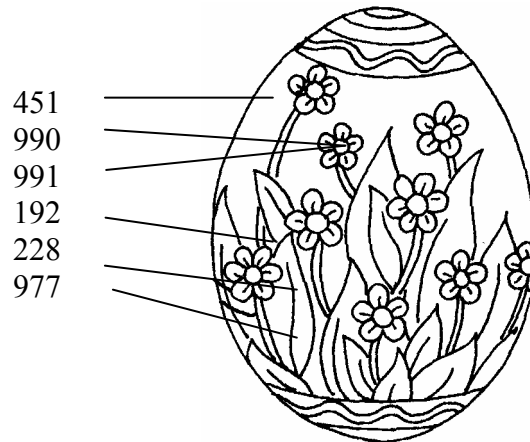


CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR FLOWER EGG

Stamps
1451 - Flower Egg
312 - Dot Background
Cardstock
8 ½" x 5 ½" - Cream Linen
2 1/8" x 2 ¾" - Sea Mist (x2)
2" x 2 ¾" - Cream Linen (x 2)
2 1/8" x 2 7/8" - Sea Mist
2 3/8" x 3 1/8" - Sea Mist
2 ½" x 3 ¼" - Cream Linen
Markers
990 - Light Sand
451 - Sky Blue
991 - Light Ochre
025 - Light Orange
977 - Saddle Brown
192 - Asparagus
228 - Grey Green



Instructions

1. Emboss **1451 - Flower Egg** in Moss, once on each 2" x 2 ¾" - Cream Linen. Colour each piece as shown.
2. Cut Cream Linen to 8 ½" x 5 ½", score and fold down the long side. Stamp **312 - Dot Background** by applying 192 - Asparagus to the rubber. Stamp the upper left and bottom right side with the dots. Apply the 2 1/8" x 2 ¾" - Sea Mist to the top right and bottom left parts of the card.
3. Punch a small hole centered about 1/4" apart and 1" in from the top. Tie a light green bow through the holes.
4. Attach the fully coloured 2" x 2 ¾" - Cream Linen to the 2 1/8" x 2 7/8" - Sea Mist that has been edged with 192 - Asparagus. With a layer of foam tape, place this onto 2 3/8" x 3 1/8" - Sea Mist and 2 ½" x 3 ¼" - Cream Linen. With a layer of foam tape, center this onto the card under the bow.
5. Using a craft knife, trim away the inside part of the egg from the un-mounted egg. Be sure to leave the outline of the egg in place. After the center is removed, carefully cut the along the outside of the egg. Layer this onto the mounted egg with silicone glue.
6. From the center piece left over, cut out 3 of the daisies and glue adhere them in place with silicone as well.
7. Lastly, add dots of Eucalyptus stickle to the green areas on the egg and Gold to the center of each daisy.
