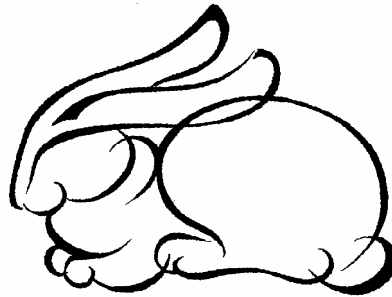


CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR BUNNY NAP

Stamps
1463 - Bunny Nap
Cardstock
7" x 5 ½" - Chocolate Metallic
5 ½" x 1 ½" - Watercolour paper
5 ½" x 1 ¾" - Olive
Markers
990 - Light Sand
969 - Chocolate



Instructions

1. Stamp **1463 - Bunny Nap** 3 times across the 5 ½" x 1 ½" - Watercolour paper by applying Tombow Marker 990 - Light Sand directly to the stamp. Repeat this on the same piece using Tombow Marker 969 - Chocolate. Stamp the bunny again in 969 - Chocolate twice on a scrap of watercolour paper.
2. Using water and a paintbrush, lightly blend the outlines of the darker bunnies to give them shadow. Apply extra marker to the separate bunnies to make them darker.
3. Cut 7" x 5 ½" - Chocolate, score and fold down the long side. Layer the 5 ½" x 1 ½" - Watercolour Paper onto 5 ½" x 1 ¾" - Olive then onto the front of the card approx ¾" from the bottom edge.
4. Place a strip of 1/8" thick double sided tape on each side of the mounted piece. Apply Art Institute 165 - Autumn glitter to each strip
5. Cut out one bunny entirely and the head attached to it backside from the coloured scrap piece. Layer them onto of the center bunny using silicone glue.
