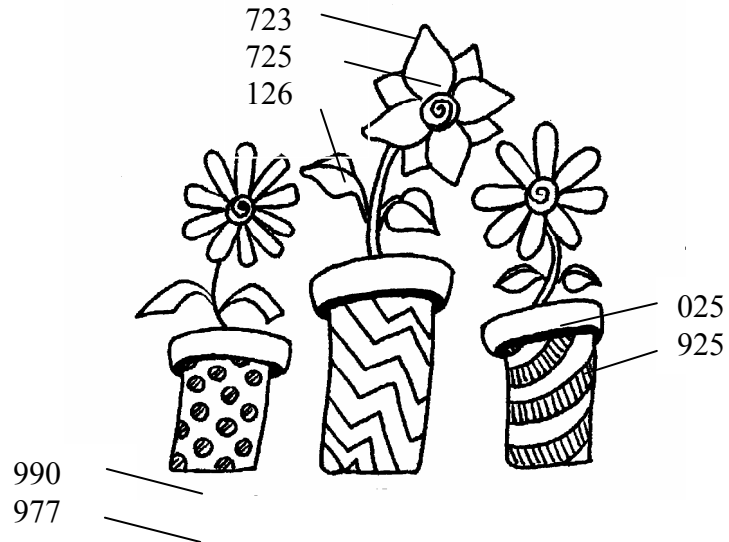


CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR DANCING FLOWER POTS

Stamps
1467 - Dancing Flower Pots
1025 - Art Washes
Cardstock
4 ¼" x 11" - Ivory Linen (score at 3 ½" and 7")
4 ¼" x ½" - Black
4 ¼" x 2" - Turquoise
2" x 2" - Watercolour (2)
Markers
990 - Light Sand
977 - Saddle Brown
025 - Light Orange
925 - Scarlet
723 - Pink
725 - Rhodamine Red
126- Eucalyptus



Instructions

1. Fold the ivory linen card with the 3 ½" sections together. Fold the longer flap back on top of the one you did first.
2. Using Black permanent ink, stamp **1467 - Dancing Flower Pots** on the longer flap opposite the crease and once onto each 2" x 2" - Watercolour. In the area left below the pots, stamp the verse **1025 - Art Washes** in the same black ink.
3. Colour the stamped image as shown using water and a paintbrush on both the card and flowers of each watercolour piece.
4. Using pencil, make a line across the 4 ¼" lengths keeping it 2" from the bottom crease. Cut carefully across this line and around back of the flowers.
5. Mount the 4 ¼" x ½" - black behind the flowers leaving about 1/8" showing. Layer the 4 ¼" x 2" - Turquoise piece behind the black covering only until the top crease on the ivory linen. Then secure the entire front panel down using glue.
6. Cut out the flower heads and flower centers from the watercolour paper and layer them in place using silicone glue.
7. Lastly, add Orange stickles to the flower pots and Fruit Punch to the flowers.
