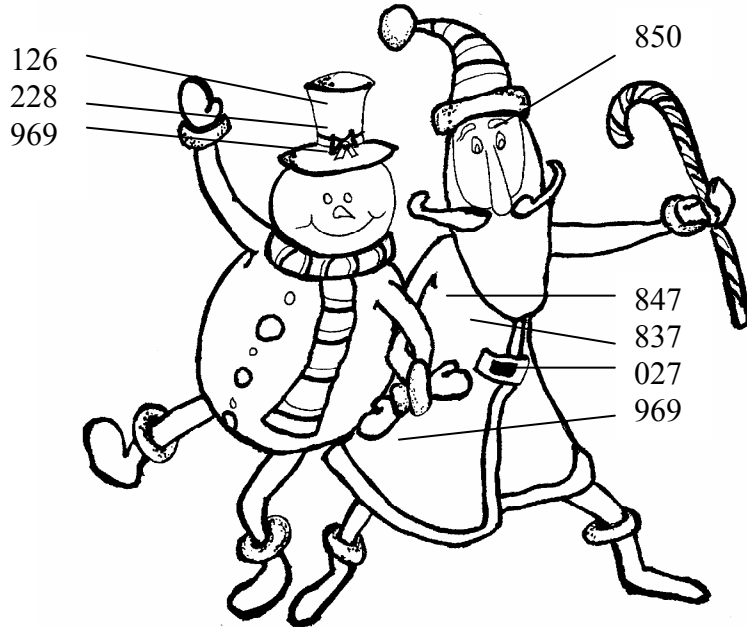


CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR DECEMBER 26TH

Stamp
1490- December 26 th
743 – Snowman Poop
Cardstock
4 ½” x 11 – Citrine
1 7/8” x 3 ½” – Ivory Linen
2” x 3 5/8” – Black
2 ¼” x 3 7/8” – Red Linen
watercolour paper (4” x 4”)
Tombow Markers
126 –Light Olive
228 – Gray Green
969 – Chocolate
847 – Crimson
837 – Wine Red
027 – Dark Ochre
850 – Flesh



Instructions

1. Using Black permanent ink, stamp **1490 – December 26th** once on a piece of watercolour paper. Colour *Santa* and the *Snowman* as show above. When it is dry, cut out around the edges.
2. Cut a 4 ½” x 11 – Citrine, score and fold down the center of the long side.
3. Using Adirondack Lettuce, stamp **743 – Snowman Poop** centered onto 1 7/8” x 3 ½” – Ivory Linen. Layer this onto 2” x 3 5/8” – Black and 2 ¼” x 3 7/8” – Red Linen with glue. Place this in the top left corner of the folded citrine card leaving ¼” on each side.
4. Decorate *Santa* and the *Snowman* using perfect puff on the hats and shoes, along with a little on the red cloak. Add 85-crystal to the beard, candy cane and snowman body.
5. With a layer of foam tape, adhere this to the bottom right corner of the card making sure none of the pieces go over the edges.
