

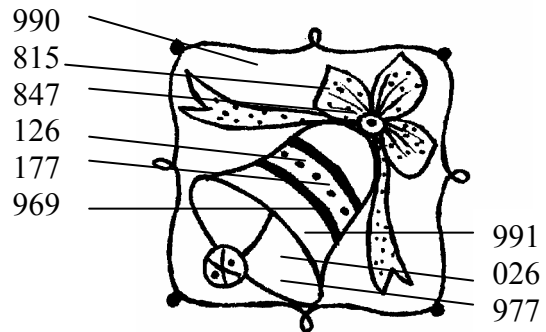
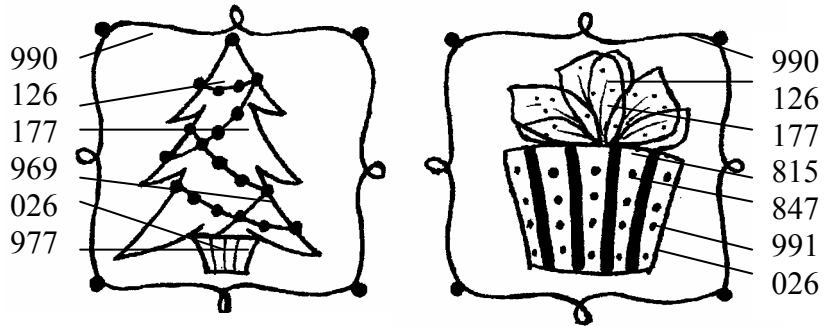
## CLASS INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRADITIONAL XMAS CUBE

**Stamp**  
1491-Traditional Xmas Cube

**Cardstock**  
6" x 7 1/2" – Rusted Metallic  
2 3/4" x 7 1/8" – Citrine  
2" x 2" – Gold Metallic  
1 7/8" x 1 7/8" – Watercolour

**Tombow Markers**

991- Light Ochre  
026 – Yellow Gold  
977 – Saddle Brown  
815 – Cherry  
847 – Crimson  
969 – Chocolate  
126 – Light Olive  
177 – Dark Jade  
990 – Light Sand



### Instructions

1. Emboss in gold the tree, present and bell from this cube centered onto 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" – Watercolour. Colour each as shown above using a paintbrush and water.
2. Cut a 6" x 7 1/2" – Rusted Metallic, score and fold down the center of the 6". Using Archival Crimson, stamp the Christmas ball randomly on the 2 3/4" x 7 1/8" – Citrine. Glue this piece onto the front of the folded card.
3. Glue each finished tree, bell and present onto a 2" x 2" – Gold Metallic. Layer this with foam tape onto the front of the folded card as well in a line from top to bottom keeping an equal amount of space between each.
4. Lastly, add Xmas Red Stickles to the red coloured areas and Lime Green Stickles to the green areas.
